

About the Scholarship

Each year the Catholic Education Foundation awards up to five scholarships (\$500 each). One scholarship will be awarded to a student at St. Dominic Catholic High School, one to a student at St. Gabriel Online School or St. John Paul II School, and three to students at École Secondaire Notre Dame High School.

The scholarships are to encourage and support students' pursuit of post-secondary studies. They are awarded to Grade 12 students who demonstrate excellence in academics, leaderships and Christian values. The scholarships are presented at students' high school annual award ceremonies.

Eligibility Criteria

- Student must be enrolled in Grade 12 with Red Deer Catholic Regional Schools
- Student must be accepted at a recognized post-secondary educational institution;
- Student should demonstrate an understanding and application of Catholic Christian teachings.

How to Apply

- The application form must be completed;
- Two letters of reference are required. They may be from an employer, teacher, principal, parish priest, or someone familiar with the applicant's community involvement;
- Applications must be post-marked and handed in to your school counsellor no later than May 19, 2017.
