<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The 50/50 Draw was approved by Archbishop Smith in 2009. The Archdiocese gambling policy pertains to three harmful gambling practices, namely, casinos, VLTs and high-stakes bingos. This project does not involved dangerous activities that feed addictive personalities and cause great harm. The Archbishop deemed it a fun way for staff to support the Education Foundation. The payroll deduction plan for the 50/50 Draw is open to all <i>regularly scheduled staff</i> and School Board Trustees. Each \$5 increment buys one ticket. The maximum amount of dollars that an employee may contribute is \$20 representing 4 tickets. A participant may change his/her withdrawal (cease, increase or decrease) ONCE over a 12-month period. No tax receipt will be issued for these contributions. The Draw will take place on the last working day of the month.
